Sub: Provision of dustbin in Non-AC coaches under Mission 'Swachh Bharat Abhiyan'.

Presently dustbins are not being provided in non-AC ICF design coaches and it has been observed that this leads to difficulty for the passengers in proper disposal of garbage generated during journey. During Hon'ble PM's address to the nation on the 'Mann Ki Baat' programme on All India Radio on 02.11.2014, a mention of feedback by one Mr. Bharat Gupta on 'mygov' portal was made, it was highlighted that there is no arrangement for dustbins for throwing garbage in certain coaches. The issue of provision of dustbins in non-AC ICF design coaches was examined and Board (MM) has approved the proposal to provide dustbins in non-AC coaches.

Accordingly to meet the objective of Mission 'Swachh Bharat Abhiyan' ICF, RCF/KXH, RCF/RBL and BEML are advised to provide suitable dustbins with pedal operated lid opening mechanism below the outside wash basin in all newly manufactured coaches. Besides, PUs are also advised to issue Carriage Alteration Instructions for retrofitment of dustbins in non-AC coaches by the Zonal Railways for different design of coaches already in service and without such provisions. It is further advised that provision of dustbins in non-AC LHB/Hybrid coaches should also be continued with. Zonal Railways are advised for ensuring regular emptying of these dustbins provided in non-AC coaches alongwith AC coaches at preplanned/nominated garbage disposal points/stations.
