
WATER WHEELS.

A water wheel means a wheel with vanes over its periphery and mounted on a horizontal shaft. The water, remaining at atmospheric pressure, moves over the vanes and in the process turns the wheel at a certain speed. The water stern, after turning the wheel, falls into a channel to become the tail race.


There are three types of water wheel.

- The Overshot water wheel.


The Undershot Waterwheel
