### What is an OH&S Management System?

- An Occupational Health and Safety Management System (OH&S MS) is a coordinated and systematic approach to managing health and safety risks



ISO 45001 is a global standard for Occupational Health and Safety Management System that provides a practical solution to improve the safety and health of both employees and other personnel. This standard has been designed with an intention to be applicable for any company regardless of its size, type and nature.

ISO 45001 training enables the organisation to improve their occupational health and safety performance in preventing injury and ill-health.

- Help organizations minimize the risk of harm to all those working under their control (defined as “workers” within the standard)
