INTRODUCTION TO GEM

- The Government e Marketplace (GeM) platform was launched on 9th August 2016.
- The GFR 2017 mandates all Ministries or Departments to procure Goods and Services available on GeM from GeM.
- An online, end to end solution for procurement of commonly used goods and services.
- For: Central Government and State Government Ministries, Departments, Public Sector Units (PSUs) and affiliated bodies.
- A trust-based system with minimal manual intervention.
- Features such as buyer and seller rating, tools to establish price reasonability and demand forecasting to help its users make more informed decisions.

PROCUREMENT MODES

- **Direct Purchase: Up to 25,000**

Direct Purchase mode shall be allowed for low value transactions and shall allow the buyer to directly procure from any available seller on GeM that meets the requisite quality, specification and delivery period as specified by the buyer.

- **L1 Purchase: Above 25,000 up to 5,00,000**

The Direct Purchase with L1 is for mid value transactions and allows direct procurement from the L1 seller after comparing all available sellers on the platform that meet the requisite quality, specification and delivery period as specified by the buyer. The comparison must be made between goods/services of at least three different manufacturers/OEMs and three different sellers.

- **Bid/RA**

The E-bid/Reverse Auction mode shall allow buyers to conduct an electronic bid for the goods and services on the platform.

PAYMENTS

- The GeM platform supports 100% online payments to ensure a cashless procurement process.
- Provision of e-EMD and e-PBG to stay true to the aspiration of 100% online payments.
- . GeM lays down definite timelines for payment and enforces buyers to adhere to stipulated timelines.
- Provision of GeM pool account.
